MHEDS began over 50 years ago as a joint project of the Erie Catholic Diocese Mission Office and Erie Council of Churches to provide health education to African American and Hispanic farm workers. Today, we are woven into the fabric of the Lake Erie region. We proudly serve the community as an FQHC Look-Alike with rigorous compliance standards that ensure patients receive high-quality, equitable care.

MHEDS provides primary health care services and is the sole Pennsylvania Region 5 grantee for refugee health screens. We are a Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) National Health Service Corps Site and a Pennsylvania Primary Care Loan Repayment Program Practice Site. In addition, we enjoy strong community partnerships with local refugee resettlement agencies, government agencies, schools, and other healthcare organizations. MHEDS employees provide leadership across the community from volunteer directorships, to the founding of community centers, and appointments to the mayoral New American Council.
